Carriage for Forklift

Carriage - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity, there are four sizes of hook type blade carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
